## *Review: Numbers*

- **Plot:** Israel moves on from Mt. Sinai toward the Promised Land. When Israel refuses to enter and fight for the land, the LORD disciplines them with forty years in the wilderness.
- **People:** Moses, The Israelites, Balaam and Balak



## *Preview: Deuteronomy*

- **Plot:** Following the death of the wilderness generation, Moses prepares a new generation to enter the Promised Land and prophesies of their future to come.
- **People:** Moses, The New Generation of Israelites
- Deuteronomy = “Second Law”
- Deuteronomy 1:1-5



# *Deut 1-3 | Israel's History is Recounted*

- Deut 1 | Israel refused to enter the land.
- Deut 1-2 | Israel was judged with 40 years in the wilderness.
- Deut 2-3 | The LORD defeated kings for Israel.





# *Deut 4-11 | Israel's Call to Covenant Faithfulness*

- Deut 4 | Israel is called to obey the law.
- Deut 6 | Israel is called to Obey & Love God.
- Deut 7-10 | Israel must remember their calling.
- Deut 10-11 | Israel must look at their hearts.





# *Deut 12-26 | Israel's Covenantal Commands*

- Deut 12-16 | Israel's worship must accord with God's Word.
- Deut 17-18 | Israel's leaders must be accountable to God's Word.
- Deut 19-26 | Israel's society and community must be just and merciful according to God's Word.





# *Deut 27-30 | Covenant Blessings & Curses*

- Deut 27 | Blessing & Curses are represented by two mountains.

- Deut 28 | Blessings & Curses are detailed.
- Deut 29 | The Covenant is confirmed.
- Deut 30 | Moses prophesies curse & promises restoration.





# *Deut 31-34 | Moses's Last Words*

- Deut 31 | Joshua is commissioned to lead Israel.
- Deut 32 | Moses gives a song of warning.
- Deut 33 | Moses gives a song of blessing.
- Deut 34 | Moses dies.





# *Deuteronomy, Jesus, & The New Covenant*

- Jesus is the prophet predicted by Moses. (John 1:21; Acts 3:20-26)
- Christ took the curse of the law on himself. (Deut 21:22-23; Gal 3:10-13)
- The New Covenant sees Israel's promises of a new heart come to fulfillment. (Ezek 36:22-26; Jer 31:31-34; Romans 2:28)
